

## **For Volunteers who are under 16 years old:**

Decorate a big box with animal pictures and place this box, with permission of the owner, in a store or public area. Make a sign that asks people to donate dog, puppy, cat or kitten supplies to the Northeast Animal Shelter. (See our “Things We Need” list @ [www.northeastanimalshelter.org](http://www.northeastanimalshelter.org))

Post Northeast Animal Shelter’s “Things We Need” list in your school or neighborhood.

Pennies for Pets/Dimes for Dogs – Create an event throughout your neighborhood, school, library, scout troop, etc.. Drop off the rolled coins at Northeast Animal Shelter with the information on who participated in the event and who organized the project.

Create a drawing or poem and submit it to Northeast Animal Shelter for possible publishing in our Animal Tales Newsletter.

Return cans for deposits - can be done as a fundraiser to purchase something from the Northeast Animal Shelter “Things We Need” list.

Members of churches, temples, scout troops and other organizations frequently hold collection drives and special fundraisers (bake sales, car washes, yard sales, etc...) in support of Northeast Animal Shelter.
